From the Deacon's Desk: Bonhoeffer

Recently, a movie about the life and death of German theologian and martyr, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, hit the theaters. "Bonhoeffer: Pastor, Spy, Assassin" is based on a recent biography by Eric Metaxes. Unfortunately, according to most Bonhoeffer scholars and experts, as well as Bonhoeffer's own family members, the book and the film are a serious misrepresentation of Bonhoeffer's life and theology.

Bonhoeffer was an important religious figure in Germany during the Nazi regime. A Lutheran pastor, he and others stood up against Hitler and his fascism. He was killed by the Nazis in 1945, right before the German surrender. Today, many are invoking Bonhoeffer's memory with the rise in authoritarianism around the world.

Because we are in such a "Bonhoeffer" moment, I hope you will join me at the beginning of the new year for a six-week look at Dietrich Bonhoeffer's life and works, as we discuss how he is relevant in today's political and religious climate.




Adult Faith Formation Opportunities—Sunday Mornings at 9:15am
